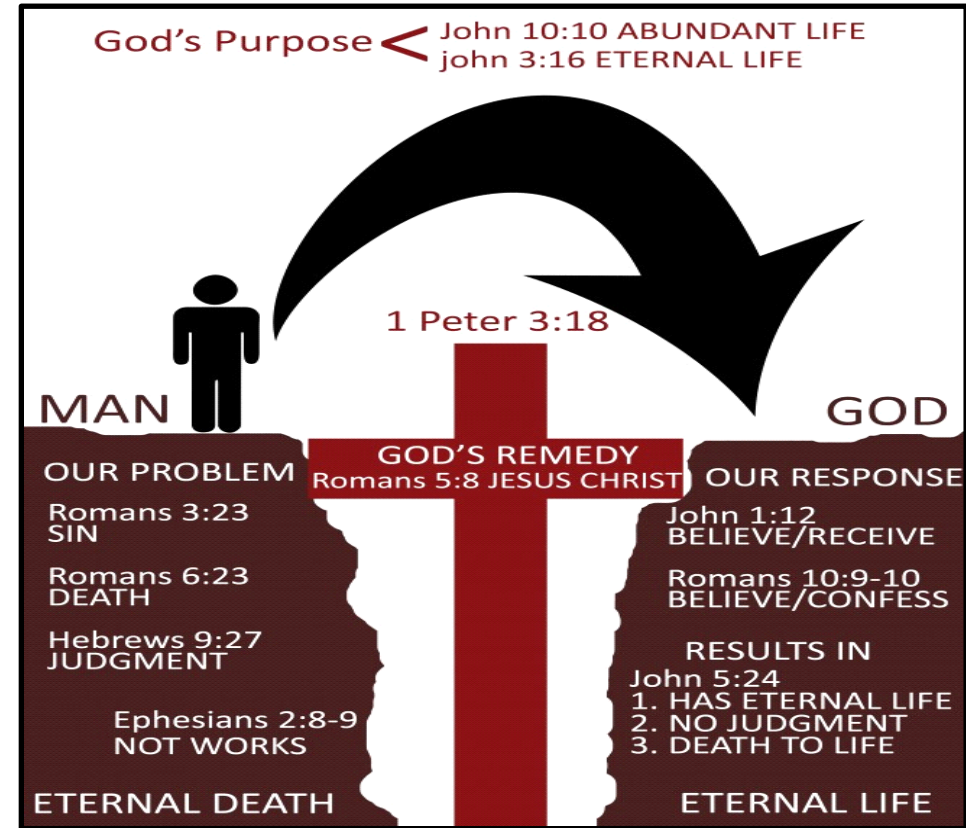

David Was Restored
2 Samuel 12:7–31

The Lord blessed David and gave him everything he had - v. 7–8

- The Lord personalized His grace to David with four times.
- The Lord will never fail to provide - **Psalm 37:4–5 Delight yourself also in the LORD, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass.**

David's sin - v. 7–10

- David committed adultery - **Leviticus 20:10**
- David committed murder - **Exodus 21:14**
- David committed high handed sin - **Numbers 15:30–31**
- David disqualified himself from being king just like Saul - **Deuteronomy 17:18–20**

David repented - v. 10–14

- David lost the blessing in his house and was put to personal shame and disgrace.
- David made no excuses and accepted all the consequences.
- David repented - **Psalm 51:3–4; 16–19**

David suffered an immediate loss for his sin - v. 15–23

- David prayed for the child because of the Lord's mercy and grace.
- David lost his son as a consequence of his sin.
- David's son was unnamed, uncircumcised, and cut-off from the covenant.
- David believed he would see his son again in the resurrection.

David was restored - v. 24–31

- The Lord gave David a son - Solomon (His peace); Jedidiah (beloved of the Lord)
- The Lord gave David the blessing of the kingdom of God.

Contrast the two sons:

The first son represented sin, judgment, wrath, and death.

The second son represented mercy, grace, forgiveness, righteousness, love, and life.

The most important difference between David and Saul was not character and works.

The most important difference between David and Saul was grace and faith.

The most important difference between David and Saul was not how each man dealt with the Lord, but how the Lord dealt with each man.

Sin nearly destroyed David but he was saved in God's promised Son.

Sin nearly destroyed Christ but He overcame sin as God's promised Son.

Sin may nearly destroy you but you can be saved in God's promised Son - **Romans 3:22–26 For there is no difference; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,**
