The End of Sin and Death

(Rev 20:7-15)

- I. **Introduction:** The perfect world...
- II. **Exposition:** The final destruction of sin and evil in the world
 - A. The decisive defeat of Satan (vv.7-10)
 - B. The eternal judgment of sinners (vv.11-13)
 - Who will stand before God's judgment throne? (vv.12-13)
 - A case for a general resurrection and judgment (Daniel 12:2; Matt 25:31ff; John 5:28-29; Acts 24:15; 2 Cor 5:10; Rom 14:10)
 - On what basis will everyone be judged? (v.12; Jer 17:10)
 - C. The final destruction of death (v.14)
- III. **Application:**
 1. Let the sobering reality of eternal punishment move us to reach the lost (2 Cor 5:11a)
 2. Live in light of the judgment to come
 - It will motivate us to avoid sin (2 Cor 5:9-10; Acts 24:15-16; Rom 14:10)
 - It will motivate us to do good works (Rev 14:10)
 3. Rejoice in God's electing and sovereign grace
 - Your name is written in the Lamb's book of life
 - You have passed from death to life (Rom 8:1; John 5:24)
 4. Rejoice in our glorious future
