The Shepherd Deals with Stubborn and Straying Sheep

Stubborn Straying Sheep of Samaria and Jerusalem Reject Jesus

- Jesus prepares to finish His work by going to Jerusalem to die. He wanted to minister in Samaria. *The Samaritans rejected Him and refused to welcome Him.* Jesus refused to damn them— yet (Luke 9:51-56).
- Jesus went to Jerusalem to die for His sheep as the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep (John 10).
- The Jews in Jerusalem rejected Jesus too. They cried “crucify Him!” They cried “His death be on us and our children!” They received their request. Even bleeding on the cross and gasping for breath, Jesus prayed “Father, forgive them for they know not what they do!”

The Good Shepherd Gently Handles Ignorant Sheep

Although many rejected the Lord Jesus Christ, not all did.

A Samaritan woman was thirsty and did not know it. She tried to fill her life with husbands. Women probably did not like her. Good men avoided her. She came to the well when she would be alone.

She found a Jewish rabbi willing to talk. He answered her objections about social conventions and religion.

He said that *He Himself could give her water that would completely satisfy.* She would never thirst again! Jn 4
