*Must be Maintained . . .*, (Neh. 13:11)

B. . . . Through a *Faith* that is \_\_\_\_\_ by a Cleaned and Well-Ordered Church, (Neh. 13:14)

**Key Phrase**—v. 11a: "*So I contended with the rulers, and said, 'Why is the house of God forsaken?'*"
