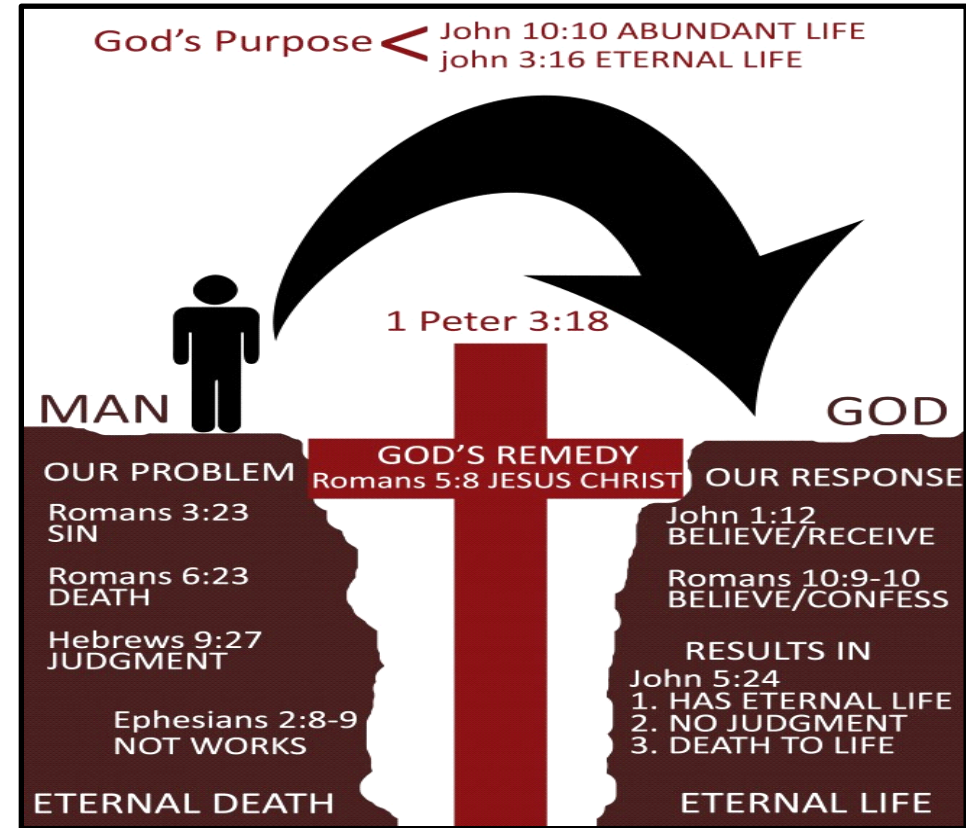

David, A Man After God's Own Heart
1 & 2 Samuel

The mercies of David - **Psalm 89:1-4**

I Will Sing of the Mercies of the Lord Hymn #48

The Lord chose David.

1 Samuel 13:14 - The people chose Saul according to their heart. The Lord chose David according to His heart. God declared His choice around 10 years before David was born.

1 Samuel 16:7 - David was around 12 years old with no qualifications to be king. The Lord works through a man's heart to accomplish His purposes.

1 Samuel 17:34-36; 45-47 - David defeated Goliath. David trusted and obeyed the Lord and the Lord gave the victory!

The Lord grew David's character through the difficulties He brought him through.

1 Samuel 23:16 - Jonathan encouraged David to be confident and courageous in God's will.

1 Samuel 30:6 - David strengthened his resolve to accomplish God's will.

The Lord used David an example of imputing righteousness to the ungodly - **Romans 4:5-8**

- The Jews thought Abraham deserved (he didn't) God's righteousness.
- David received God's (*hesed*) mercy and loving-kindness- **Isaiah 55:3 Incline your ear, and come to Me. Hear, and your soul shall live; And I will make an everlasting covenant with you—The sure mercies of David.**
- David confessed his sin - **Psalm 32:5 I acknowledged my sin to You, And my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah**
- David believed that a right relationship with God (justification) did not and could not depend upon works but necessitated God's forgiveness of sins, God's covering of sins, and God's refraining from imputing of sins.
- The blessedness David speaks of is God's grace to bestow His favor upon the sinner. There is a divine blessedness (joy, peace, satisfaction) that pours over the one who believes rather than the one who works.

The Lord set the Son of David upon the throne of David forever.

- The Lord made a covenant with David - **2 Samuel 7:8-18**
- David died and Solomon sat on the throne and built the temple - **1 Kings 2:10-12**
- The prophecy of resurrection spoken by David did not come to pass in him but would be fulfilled by the Messiah, who would be David's descendant (fruit of his body) who will sit on his throne forever - **Acts 2:25-36**

The Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of David, is the man after God's own heart and in Him are the mercies of David - **Isaiah 55:3 Incline your ear, and come to Me. Hear, and your soul shall live; And I will make an everlasting covenant with you—The sure mercies of David.**

Being *a man after God's own heart* is not about how committed you are to God.

Being *a man after God's own heart* is being in Christ through faith.
