Romans 11:33

Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! (ESV)

Measuring the Measureless Wealth of God

The depth of the riches of God:

God has made the earth and all that is in it. All is God's; the wealth of the world is His to dispense as He pleases (Psalm 50).

He **pays** His people's taxes with coins swallowed by fish (Matthew 17:24-27). He **feeds** widows with oil that does not run out. Manna from heaven, angel's food, is the bread of heaven **freely bestowed** on His own, for He is our Father (Matthew 6:25-33; John 6).

Measuring the Measureless Wisdom of God

All wisdom is God's. He is God only wise. He is Wisdom personified in Proverbs, inviting His people to partake of Divine wisdom for our own good (Proverbs 8). **From creation to redemption to His Son's glorification, all God does is wise and good.**

He is the **Wonderful Counselor** (Isaiah 9:6). God shares His wisdom freely and graciously.

He is the fount of wisdom, the dispenser of the medicine of Life (James 1). He it was who gave Solomon the wisdom to write thousands of proverbs and cause the Queen of Sheba to marvel.

Measuring the Measureless Knowledge of God

Our God is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and end of all things. **He knows all things.** He knows all that was, all that is, and all that will be– the past, present and future have always been fully known by our God (Matthew 11:20-24).

God knows the ways of nations and the lives of people.

Solomon wisely sought wisdom from the **One who searches and knows men's hearts (1 Chronicles 28:9)**. God's Word describes those who serve God, but not with all their hearts.

Describing the Ineffable Ways of God

His ways are **inscrutable**— past searching or finding out!

His judgments are **unsearchable**- mysterious, but higher better and wiser than our greatest wisdom. Sometimes we must simply accept His work and judgment as best by faith. His foolishness exceeds our greatest wisdom!

His ways are **unfathomable**– far beyond our understanding!
