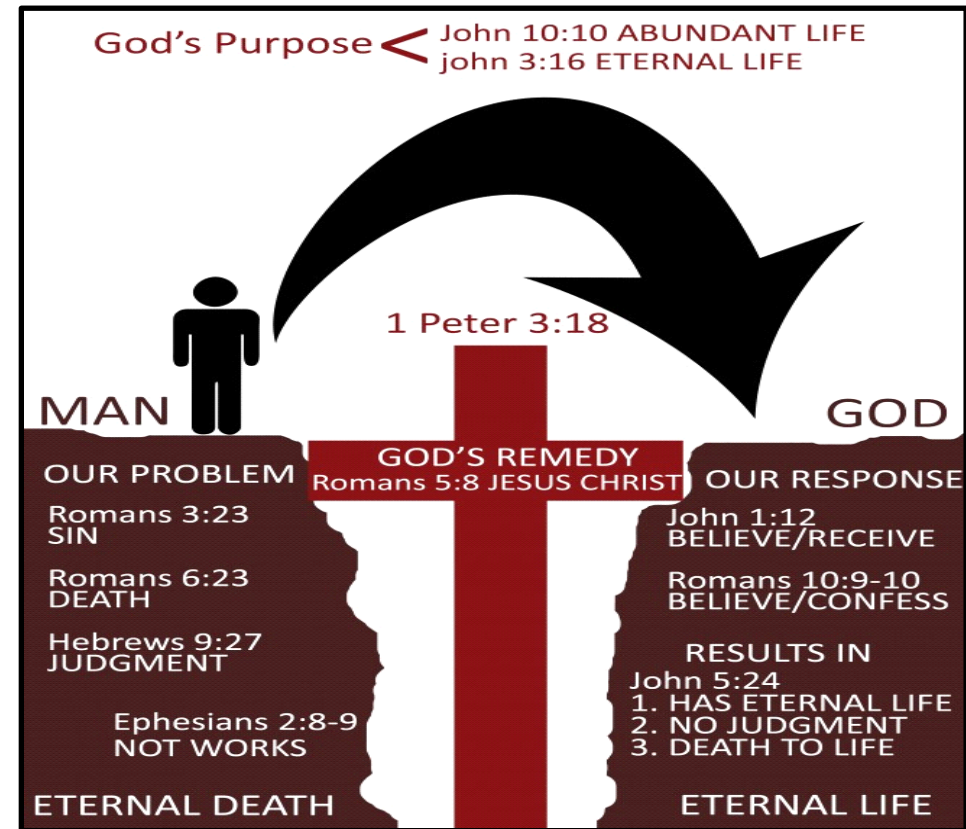

**Believing Christ's Power to Heal**  
**Luke 8:40–48**

Jesus gave four demonstrations of who He was and what He could do.  
Jesus did these things to teach us what faith in Him looks like.

The disciples of Jesus must believe that he has the power to heal all sickness.

The woman was desperate for healing - v. 43

- The woman suffered for twelve long years.
- The woman tried everything she could but could not be healed.
- The woman's *flow of blood* made her disqualified and an outcast (Lev 15:19–33).
- The woman was spiritually unclean - **Leviticus 15:31 Thus you shall separate the children of Israel from their uncleanness, lest they die in their uncleanness when they defile My tabernacle that is among them.**
- Because of sin, all of us are unclean both inwardly and outwardly - **Isaiah 64:6 But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.**

Jesus is the only One who can heal and restore a broken life - v. 44

- The woman came from behind because she was an outcast.
- The woman believed she just needed to touch the edge of Jesus' garment - **Malachi 4:2 But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings;**
- *Wings*: wings of birds; to cover; an extremity; the tip or edge of a garment; the fold of the garment (Num 15:38-41).
- The Messiah will have healing in the extremities of His covering light—even the hem of His garment!

Jesus responded to the woman's faith - v. 45–48

- Jesus' power is not automatic or mechanical.
- A crowd of people were touching Jesus, but this woman touched Him differently.
- Jesus called this woman out to test her.
- The woman responded to Jesus both with a little faith and a great faith.
- In spite of her fear (she's not supposed to touch anyone), she believed in Jesus.
- She was convicted and confident she must go to Jesus and confess to Him.
- The woman overcame fear with her faith.
- Jesus declared that He healed her because of her faith.
- Jesus saved her soul (Luk 19:10; 8:36; 8:12; 7:50; 4:18) - **Luke 19:10 for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.**
- Jesus healed and restored her life (Luk 4:18; Jam 5:15) - **James 5:15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.**

Brother and sister, faith overcomes fear. Believe Jesus can heal your life.
