A. INTRODUCTION TO PRAYER (vv14-15)

1. Humble posture (v14)
2. Addressed to the sovereign Father (v15)

B. REQUEST FOR STRENGTH (vv16-18)

1. This strength is according to the riches of God's glory (v16a)
2. This strength is with power (v16b)
3. This strength is through the Spirit (v16c)
4. This strength is in the inner man (v16d)
5. This strength results in a "homey" heart for Christ (v17)
6. This strength results in a comprehension of the Spirit's power (v18)

B. REQUEST TO KNOW THE UNKNOWABLE LOVE OF CHRIST (v19a)

C. REQUEST TO BE FILLED TO THE FULLNESS OF GOD (v19b)

D. DOXOLOGY (vv20-21)

1. God's greatness (v20)
 - a. God is not idle (v20a)
 - b. He is able to do far more than can be asked or imagined (v20b)
2. God's glory (v21)
 - a. Displayed in the church (v21a)
 - b. Displayed in Christ Jesus (v21b)
 - c. Displayed to all generations forever (v21c)
