1. love to all believers, 13:1
2. love to believing strangers, 13:2
3. love to the imprisoned, 13:3

13:1, love exhibited to all believers

1. φιλαδελφία (*fil-ad-el-FEE-a*): brotherly affection
 - a. Rom 12:10; 1 Thess 4:9; Heb 10:24-25
 - b. John 13:35; 21:15-17
2. μενέτω (*men-ET-ō*); “continue”
 - a. remain; stand immovable
 - b. “Let brotherly affection be monumental.”
 - i. John 13:35

13:2, love extended to believing strangers

1. φιλοξενίας (*fil-ox-en-EE-as*)
 - a. “entertain strangers” (KJV); “hospitality to strangers” (ESV)
2. ἀγγέλους (*ANG-el-oos*): messenger
 - a. believers never before met, Rom 12:13
 - b. heavenly messengers, Gen 18:1-2; 19:1; Judg 13:3
 - c. providential unbelievers, Rom 8:28-29; 13:1-4

13:3, love extended to persecuted believers

1. μιμνήσκεσθε (*mim-NĀS-kes-the*) to be mindful; recall to mind
 - a. from root, μνάομαι (*MNA-om-ai*)
 - b. Luke 23:42-43
1. δεσμίων (*des-mi-ŌN*); those in bonds; imprisoned
 - a. Matt 25:36
2. κακουχομένων (*kak-oo-choo-MEN-on*); those maltreated, tormented
 - a. 1 Cor 12:26
 - b. Phil 2:7
3. tendency to remove ourselves from such identification
 - a. Gal 2:11-14
