## Ruth 3

**Theme: A gentile becomes the recipient of God's blessing**

*Three things about Ruth that highlight her "kindness"/loyalty (3:10):*

### I. RUTH'S V \_\_\_\_\_ (1-7)

#### A. In W\_\_\_\_\_ She Sought

The action Naomi is instructing is to enable Ruth to find \_\_\_\_\_.

#### B. In the W\_\_\_\_\_ She Sought It

Your rest will not be found in any man, but the Man \_\_\_\_\_!

C\_\_\_\_\_ is involved in presenting the gospel (I Thess. 1:5).

### II. RUTH'S V \_\_\_\_\_ (8-13)

#### A. D\_\_\_\_\_ to Her Trust in God

*"Under whose wings thou art come to t\_\_\_\_\_"* (Ruth 2:12)

#### B. D\_\_\_\_\_ in Her Commitment to Naomi

Ruth's change of \_\_\_\_\_ was on display *"at the beginning"* (3:10)!

#### C. D\_\_\_\_\_ in Her Pursuit of Boaz

Ruth's loyalty is now d\_\_\_\_\_ *"in the latter end"* (3:10).

Both the word "kinsman" and "redeem" in Ruth can, in each separate occurrence be combined to say "k\_\_\_\_\_ r\_\_\_\_\_."

### III. RUTH'S V \_\_\_\_\_ (14-18)

Due to the actions of a kinsman redeemer, Naomi's \_\_\_\_\_ days are over!

**Ruth 3 begins with r\_\_\_\_\_ and ends with r\_\_\_\_\_.**
